

2025 Competition terms and conditions for International House Bristol (IHB)

- 1 The competition is open to entries from 28th October to 10th November 2024
- 2 4-8 winners will be chosen depending on the quality of the entries
- 3 Entries must be received by 23.59 on 10th November 2024 to be valid
- 4 Applicants must be aged 18 or older by 31st December 2024
- 5 Applicants must be available to travel to the UK for the dates of the competition: 5th January to 29th March 2025
- 6 The competition is open to students from A2 to C1 (Elementary to Lower Advanced)
- 7 The judges' decision is final in all cases and the winners will be notified via email by 15th November 2024 and announced on our website by 30th November 2024
- 8 The course offered is 12 weeks of General English 20 (morning classes from 9:15 to 12:45, Monday to Friday) course starting on Monday, 6th January 2025
- 9 How to enter:
Applicants must write a piece of English of between 200 and 500 words explaining why they would like to study in Bristol and how this competition would benefit them in the future
The piece must be typed
Any use of AI will result in automatic disqualification
Entries must be sent to info@ihbristol.com with the subject line '*General English 3-month competition*'
Applicants must return a signed T&Cs form (see below for signature)
Applicants must submit a photograph of themselves to be used at the discretion of International House Bristol (IHB)
Applicants must submit details of all/any special needs when entering the competition
- 10 The course cannot be exchanged for cash or given to another person
- 11 Applicants agree to the following:
 - The winners will take the course between 5th January and 28th March 2025
 - The winners' photographs will appear on the IH Bristol website and on all IHB social media channels and any other social media channels sanctioned by IHB
 - The winners agree to take part in video and picture media to be shown on the IHB website and social media channels and any other social media channels sanctioned by IHB
 - The winners will pay their own travel and insurance costs
 - The winners will be responsible for their own food and catering during their time in Bristol
 - Winners must inform IHB by 17th November whether they intend to take up the competition or not after which date it will be offered to the next best entry
 - The winners will pay the special package price of £3000 by 26th November 2024 at the latest
- 12 The total cost of the package offered in the competition is £6683. Winners pay only £3000.
- 13 All winners may choose to upgrade their course from 20 lessons per week to 30 lessons per week at a cost of £504
- 14 Any materials associated with an upgrade to be paid by the winner
- 15 No refunds are given for early departure or illness
- 16 All winners are strongly advised to take out insurance
